

Please read the instructions below, before applying to 2022 Clean Combustion Winter School.

1. As the Winter School will take place on KAUST campus, please ensure that your country is *not* in the restricted entry list for Saudi Arabia.

Saudi Arabia has temporarily suspended entry into the Kingdom for all guests coming from Indonesia, Pakistan, Brazil, Turkey, Lebanon, Egypt, India, Ethiopia, Afghanistan, Vietnam, and same applies to those who are coming from other countries if they have passed through any of the aforementioned countries during (14) days preceding their entry to the Kingdom.

- 2. Due to COVID, we will consider only *fully vaccinated applicants*. You will be required to provide proof of full vaccination (vaccine certificates for COVID 19) with one of the following vaccines, as part of your application:
 - a) 2 doses of Pfizer BioNTech.
 - b) 2 doses of Oxford AstraZeneca.
 - c) 2 doses of Moderna.
 - d) 1 dose of Johnson and Johnson's Janssen.
 - e) 2 doses of Sinopharm vaccine and one dose of either Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, or Janssen.
 - f) 2 doses of Sinovac vaccine and one dose of either Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, or Janssen.

If you are not vaccinated with any of the above-mentioned vaccine sequences, please do not apply.

3. If you meet criteria 1 and 2, you are eligible to apply. The Winter School will enable students to work on specific research projects (under the broad umbrella of 'Clean Combustion') offered by KAUST faculty during the 3—week workshop. Students should choose any *one* research project as part of their application for the workshop. Please go through all the listed research projects on https://ccws.kaust.edu.sa/research-projects to understand and determine which faculty you will be applying for in this workshop.

- 4. After determining your research project, click on https://ccws.kaust.edu.sa/register and create your account.
- 5. Fill in the Clean Combustion Winter School application form, and upload the below documents:
- a) CV/Resume
- b) Transcripts for BS degree (and MS degree, if applicable)
- c) Statement of Purpose (one-page document about your academic background and motivation for applying to Winter School)
- d) Passport
- e) Proof of Full vaccination
- 6. Submit your application after uploading all documents.

Applications close on October 31, 2021

Next Steps: Shortlisted applicants will be informed on November 15, 2021. All short-listed applicants will be invited to an interview with our Admissions team over Skype. We will announce the final list of accepted students on December 5, 2021.
